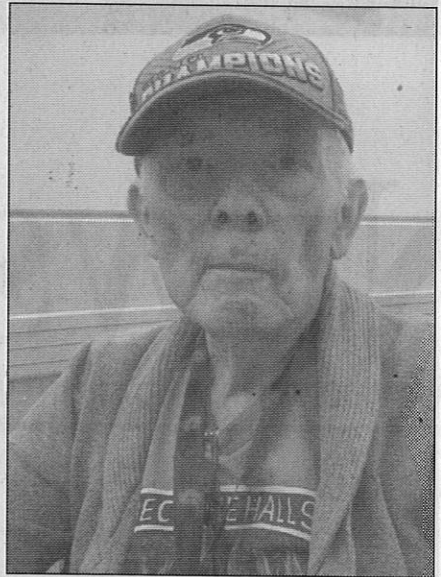
Mr. Olsen worked as a carpenter and fisherman before retiring. He was a model boat builder.

Mr. Olsen was a member of the Improved Order of Red Men, Loyal Order of Moose, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and Sons of Norway. He was a member of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes, and a shareholder in Sealaska Corp.

Mr. Olsen was preceded in death by his parents, Margaret and Otilius Olsen; five brothers; and three sisters.
